LIMITED WARRANTY AND SOFTWARE LICENSE

WHO IS COVERED?

This Warranty applies only to the person who first bought, or was originally licensed to use, the Equipment or Software from BioAnalogics. Note that in the case of an individual purchasing any BioAnalogics system from an authorized re-seller (VAR or OEM) the warranty and license is automatically transferred to said party.

WHAT IS COVERED?

This Warranty covers the ELG hardware and related equipment (the “Equipment”) supplied by BioAnalogics or its authorized agents, together with any copies of software included with the Equipment or licensed separately by BioAnalogics (the “Software”).

Software Warranty. BioAnalogics warrants that when used as directed, the Software will perform substantially in accordance with the user manual or specifications provided.

Hardware Warranty. BioAnalogics warrants that the Equipment and the medium upon which the Software is stored is free from manufacturing defects.

WHAT IS THE DURATION OF THE WARRANTY?

The warranty is for a period of ninety days on the Software, and one year on the Hardware, from the date of delivery.

WHAT BIOANALOGICS WILL DO

BioAnalogics will replace without charge any magnetic media or Equipment that proves defective in manufacture. BioAnalogics will, at its own option, replace or correct with a corrected copy or with corrective code, any Software that does not perform in accordance with its documentation. If BioAnalogics is unable to replace defective equipment or magnetic media or is unable to provide a corrected computer program within a reasonable time, BioAnalogics will, at its sole option, either replace the software, magnetic media or equipment with a functionally equivalent program, media, or equipment or refund the fees paid for licensing or the purchase price of the software, media and equipment. These are your sole and exclusive remedies for any breach of warranty.

WHAT BIOANALOGICS WILL NOT DO

BioAnalogics does not warrant that the equipment or software will meet your requirements or that the operation of the software will be uninterrupted or error free. The warranty does not cover any media, equipment, or software that has been subjected to damage or misuse. The software warranty does not cover any computer program that has been altered or changed in any way by anyone other than BioAnalogics. BioAnalogics is not responsible for problems caused by changes in the operating characteristics of computer hardware or computer operating systems that are made after the release of the software.

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED HEREIN, BIOANALOGICS MAKES NO EXPRESS WARRANTIES OR ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY. ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE IS LIMITED TO THE DURATION OF THE WRITTEN LIMITED WARRANTIES IN THIS DOCUMENT.

BIOANALOGICS' LIABILITY UNDER THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE LIMITED TO A REFUND OF THE LICENSE FEE AND PURCHASE PRICE OF THE SOFTWARE AND EQUIPMENT.

BIOANALOGICS SHALL NOT IN ANY CASE BE LIABLE FOR SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, INDIRECT OR OTHER SIMILAR DAMAGES ARISING FROM ANY BREACH OF WARRANTY, CONTRACT, TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE), STRICT LIABILITY OR OTHERWISE, EVEN IF BIOANALOGICS OR ITS AGENT HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.

Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts or the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation or exclusions may not apply to you.

HOW YOU CAN GET SERVICE

You must call our customer service department for a return authorization during the warranty period. If our customer service representative is unable to correct your problem by telephone or (at the option of BioAnalogics) at your place of business, you will be provided with instructions for returning the defective item at BioAnalogics' expense for warranty service or replacement. You must either insure the defective item being returned or assume the risk of loss or damage in transit. Any items returned for warranty service must include a data proof of the date of delivery such as a copy of your receipt or invoice.

OTHER CONDITIONS

This warranty allocates risks of product failure between you and BioAnalogics. The warranty set out above is in lieu of all other express warranties, whether oral or written. The agents, employees, distributors and dealers of BioAnalogics are not authorized to modify this warranty, nor to make additional warranties binding on BioAnalogics. Accordingly, additional statements such as dealer advertising or presentations, whether oral or written, do not constitute warranties by BioAnalogics and should not be relied upon as a warranty of BioAnalogics.

BioAnalogics' pricing of the software and equipment reflects this allocation of risk and the limitations of liability contained in this Warranty.

No claim for breach of warranty or any other claim, tort, contract, or otherwise, may be commenced more than one year following the expiration of the warranties set out above or the accrual of the claim, whichever occurs earlier.

The limitation of liability and other provisions of this Warranty shall insure to the benefit of BioAnalogics, its assigns or successors, the author, owner, or licensor of the software any manufacturer of the equipment.

HOW STATE LAW RELATES TO THE WARRANTY

This Warranty gives the original licensee or user specific legal rights and the original licensee or user may also have other rights, which vary, from state to state.

SOFTWARE LICENSE

BioAnalogics grants to the end user a non-exclusive, paid-up license to use the software on one computer subject to the following terms:

1. Except as otherwise provided in this license, applicable copyright laws shall apply to the software.
2. Title to the medium on which the software is recorded or stored is transferred to the end user, but not title to the software.
3. The end user shall not use, make, manufacture or reproduce copies of the software except for use on one computer and as is specifically provided in this license. No one is authorized to disassemble, decompile or reverse engineer the software or any related equipment.
4. The end user is permitted to make additional copies of the software only for backup or archival purposes or if additional copies are required in the operation of one computer with the software, but only to the extent the software allows a backup copy to be made.
5. All copyright notices shall be retained on all copies of the software.
